(IMPOSITION OF 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 5, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

1. To revoke a 40mph Speed Limit on part of Barkby Road, Queniborough
2. To impose a 40mph Speed Limit on part of Barkby Road, Queniborough
